# Installation

Installation is quick and easy.  
Let's get started!

## 1. Gather your materials

Either construction adhesive or mechanical fasteners can effectively secure your corner guard to the wall, so gather your corner guards, adhesive or fasteners, and caulking gun or screwdriver to begin.

## 2. Align your corner guards in place

Use a level or tape measure to position your corner guard carefully into place. Use light pencil markings to record the position.

## 3. Apply adhesive or secure the fasteners

If using adhesive, apply enough to the back of the corner guard to make a strong connection, but not too much to make a mess. Secure lightly with painter's tape for the duration of curing time specified by the adhesive manufacturer.

If using fasteners, follow the manufacturer's directions for securing them to the wall through the pre-drilled holes on your corner guard.

## 4. Remove the protective film

Once the adhesive is dry, peel away the painter's tape and the protective film on the corner guard.

Note: if there is additional construction occurring in the area of installation, you may wait to remove the film until there is no risk that other construction trades may damage the corner guard.

## 5. You're done!

# Care

If needed, use glass cleaner or mild soap and a soft cloth. Spray the cleaner onto the surface of the product, and wipe in the direction of the grain. This will reduce any streaks left behind by the cleaner and keep your toekick looking like new for years to come.

**CAUTION:** Do not use chlorine-based or abrasive cleaners, as they may react with the finish.
